## Enhanced validation of valid prescriber identification numbers for claims adjudication

All direct bill pharmacy claims from Alberta pharmacies must be submitted with the valid Alberta prescriber identification number and applicable reference code of the prescriber who authorized the prescription.

The integrity of data submitted by pharmacies affects not only the adjudication of claims but also reporting networks such as Pharmaceutical Information Network and Alberta Netcare. In addition, it assists in determining benefit status where restricted benefits are limited by designated prescribers.

Valid prescriber identification numbers can be referenced on the Alberta College of Pharmacy (ACP) website <u>abpharmacy</u>. <u>ca/pharmacists</u> and are to be used at time of direct bill claim submission. Alpha characters as a prefix or suffix to the actual prescriber identification numbers should not be used unless the applicable college has included this as part of the prescriber identification numbers. As of March 1, 2021, the inclusion of alpha characters in prescriber identification numbers will result in a claim reject code of **D3 – Prescriber is not authorized** unless the alpha character is part of the college assigned prescriber identification numbers.

At the time of claim, the appropriate *prescriber reference code* and *prescriber ID*, as noted in the tables below, must be used.

For the Alberta prescribers listed below, the following *pseudo IDs* must be used.

For out-of-province prescribers, the appropriate prescriber reference code should be used along with the actual prescriber identification numbers.

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Only in circumstances where the prescriber identification number is unknown may the following *pseudo IDs* be used in conjunction with the appropriate prescriber reference code.
