## RECORD OF DECISION-CMOH Order 31-2020

Re: 2020 COVID-19 Response

Whereas Dr. Deena Hinshaw, Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH), initiated an investigation into the existence of COVID-19 within the Province of Alberta.

Whereas the investigation confirmed that COVID-19 is present in Alberta.

Whereas an outbreak of COVID-19 began at the Misericordia Community Hospital (MCH) on June 21, 2020.

Whereas, to limit COVID-19 spread to other Edmonton hospitals, the CMOH made Record of Decision – CMOH 30-2020 under section 29(2.1) of the Public Health Act on July 14, 2020.

Whereas Record of Decision – CMOH 30-2020 ordered the operator of MCH and each contractor operating within MCH to prohibit staff members and contracted providers who worked at the MCH on or after July 2, 2020 from providing in-person services at any health care facility other than the MSH for the 14 days following any day a staff member or contracted provider works at the MSH.

Whereas the outbreak at the MCH has now ended and COVID-19 transmission has been contained.

Whereas a number of staff members and contracted providers are required to attend at both the MCH site and other health care facilities to deliver health care services, I, Marcia Johnson, Deputy Chief Medical Officer of Health, hereby make the following Order:

Effective immediately, Record of Decision – CMOH Order 30-2020 is rescinded.
