Restrictions to food-serving facilities such as restaurants and coffee shops are also set out. Note: on March 27, 2020, gatherings were further restricted to 15 people, and new restrictions for close contact businesses, dine-in restaurants and non-essential retail services, were included in Order 07-2020.
