Just following up on our late lunch meeting on Saturday. As you know, time is of the essence. We do have a meeting booked for this Wednesday (March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023). I wanted to confirm this will be a 2 hour meeting at my home (West 35) where I have access to all the relevant material, including the affidavit I showed you on Saturday from the healthcare professional relating to the crimes committed by AHS/Alberta Health in 2021.

## Key messages

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- Starting March 18, 2021, COVID-19 positive samples will have variant of concern test results reported to the ordering clinician as they currently receive reports. Reports will also be available on Netcare and Connect Care (reporting in SCM to follow). See the appendix for example Netcare reports.
- Variant of concern test results will be reported separately from routine COVID-19 diagnostic tests (e.g., COVID-19 nucleic acid tests, the ID NOW test, antigen-based tests) as "COVID-19 Variant Nucleic Acid Test."

Result	Interpretation
Negative <b>.</b>	<ul> <li>No variant of concern is detected.</li> <li>This patient still has COVID-19.</li> </ul>
Positive	<ul> <li>A variant of concern is detected. The lineage (strain) will be reported as B.1.1.7, B.1.351, or P.1.</li> <li>"See Lineage Conf" indicates that the lineage result is pending and will be reported later.</li> </ul>
Unresolved	<ul> <li>The viral load is too low to perform variant testing.</li> <li>The strain could potentially still be a variant of concern and should not be treated as negative.</li> <li>This patient still has COVID-19.</li> </ul>

- · Positive and unresolved results will be reported as abnormal (i.e., with red font in Netcare).
- Infection prevention and control (IPC) precautions continue to be based on symptoms and risk assessment. These test results should not be used to discontinue IPC precautions.

## Background

 Current SARS-CoV-2 variants of concern include B.1.1.7, B.1.351, and P.1. It is anticipated that more variants of concern will be identified over time.

As I mentioned, the only way to end this is to brief the Chiefs of Police and Chief Prosecutors (something that Minister Mickey Amery can arrange even if the Premier does not). There are also some things that could be talked through with Chief Dale Cox (Lakeshore Police) and the other indigenous Chiefs of Police, who could also call for a Chiefs and Chiefs meeting. It's been a few years since Dale and I spoke, but I suspect he (and many of the others) will remember me, especially from the multiple appearances at the Chiefs and Chiefs including 2009 and 2011.

Looking forward to seeing you on Wednesday to take the next steps that are so urgently required.
